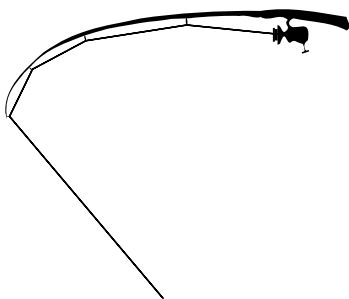
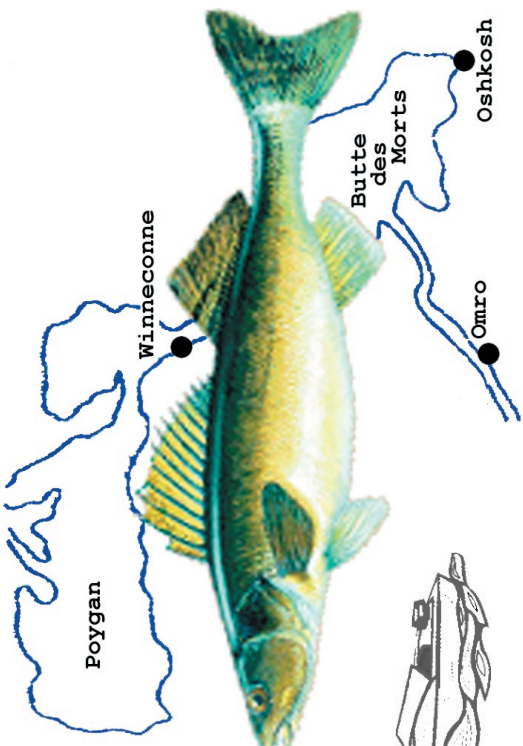

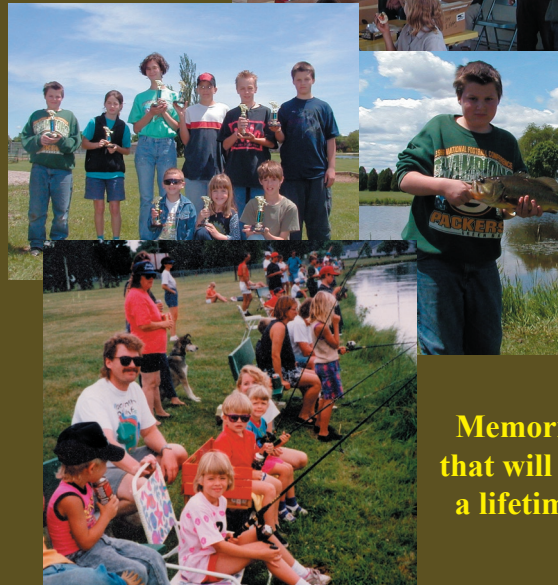
Meetings

Club Projects & Issues

Some of the projects & issues with which the club has become involved:

☞ We are involved in the development and implementation of the DNR's Lake Winnebago Comprehensive Management Plan.

☞ We traveled to Green Bay to support the closing of a lock to keep the Sea Lamprey out of the Upper Lakes and the Winnebago System.

☞ We supported state funding to complete the Terrel's Island Breakwater Project in Lake Butte des Morts.

☞ We participated in preserving the Upper Lakes cane beds, by posting signs around them which ask boaters to stay out of the cane beds.



☞ We worked with the Township of Omro to ensure safety for all boaters by putting reflective tape on the Springbrook Bridge.
